## MSc and Postgraduate Diploma in Information Security

September 2008: First supplement to the 2008–09 Regulations

Students should note the following information about the Project and the additional fees that may apply. This information should be read in conjunction with paragraph 8 of the 2008-09 Programme Regulations.

---

Students who fail the Project and wish to re-take the Project have the following options:

- Students may keep the same project topic and make another attempt with no further supervision. An examination re-entry fee of £222 will apply
- Students may keep the same project topic (or a related topic) and make another attempt with reduced supervision. The Project fee will be 50% of the standard module fee (see paragraph 8.3). An examination re-entry fee of £222 will apply
- Students may start again with a new Project topic. The full module fee for the Project will apply (see paragraph 8.3).

A student who starts the Project in one academic year, and who does not complete the formal assessment for the Project by 31 March in the same academic year, is deemed to have interrupted the Project. An interrupted Project can be resumed the following academic year and, depending on how much supervision a student received in the academic year the Project was started, there will be limited amount of supervision when the Project is resumed.

Students who interrupt their Project in two successive years will have used up all their due supervision and have the following options:

- Students may keep the same project topic and make another attempt with no further supervision.
- Students may keep the same project topic (or a related topic) and make another attempt with reduced supervision. The Project fee will be 50% of the standard module fee (see paragraph 8.3).
- Students may start again with a new Project topic. The full module fee for the Project will apply (see paragraph 8.3).
