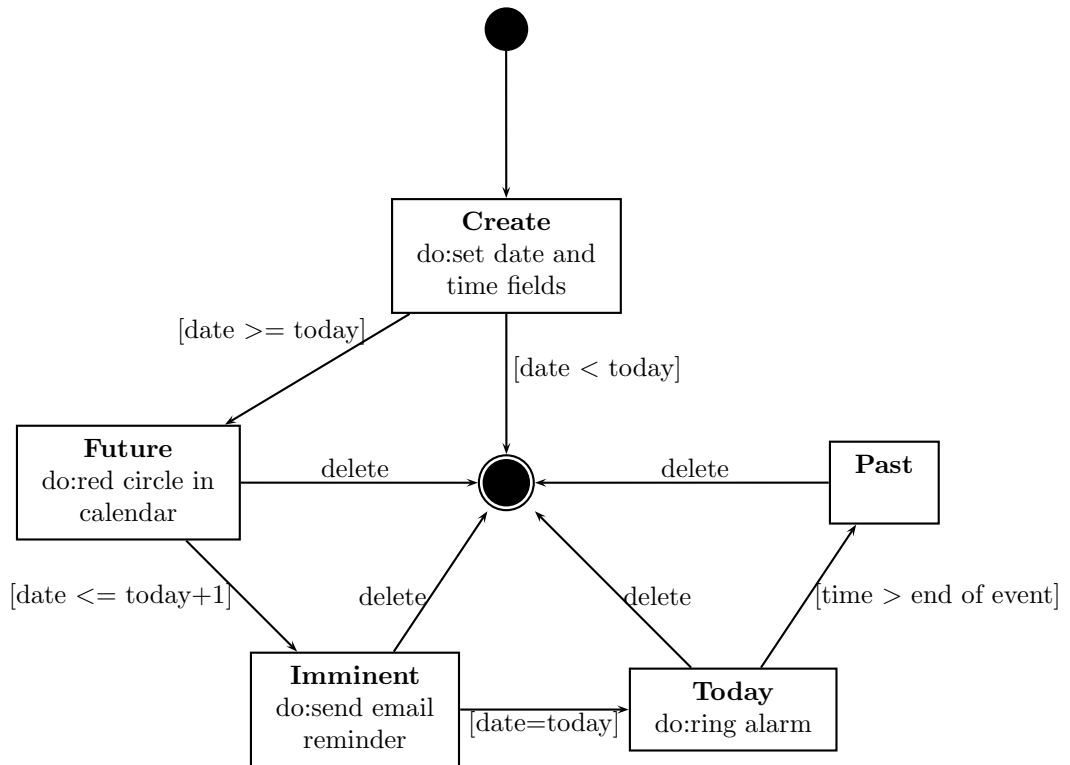


Figure 12.4: State machine for the class Event

- When a new event is **created**, either the date is less than today's date in which case the event has already passed, or the date is today or in the future.
- If the event is in the **future** then a red circle is put in the calendar.
- The event is called **imminent** if it is happening today or tomorrow. An email reminder is sent.
- If the date of the event is **today** then an alarm bell rings.
- If the date of the event is today but the time is greater than the end of the event, then the event has already finished and is **past**.
