

Travel information

The nearest Underground station is **Russell Square** (Piccadilly Line). Other Underground stations nearby include **Euston** (Victoria and Northern Lines) and **Euston Square** (Circle, Metropolitan and Hammersmith & City Lines).

Euston station (British Rail mainline) is ten minutes walk from Stewart House; **King's Cross** and **St Pancras** mainline stations are about fifteen minutes walk away.

*Note: on-street parking in Bloomsbury is very limited and is metered on Saturdays. You are strongly advised not to travel by car. Disabled drivers should note that the National 'Blue Badge' Scheme does **not** apply in the vicinity of Stewart House.*

If you are arriving by **air**, it may help you to know that there are relatively inexpensive rail links to central London. From **Heathrow**, Piccadilly underground line trains run directly to Russell Square (the Heathrow Express runs directly to Paddington where you must change to the underground – it is quicker but more expensive); from **Gatwick**, the Gatwick Express runs to Victoria, where you change to the Victoria line to Euston, alternatively (and cheaper) Thameslink trains run from Gatwick to Kings Cross (see above); from **Stansted**, the Stansted Express stops at Tottenham Hale where you change to the Victoria line to Euston: from **Luton**, Thameslink trains run directly to King's Cross.
