

# International Foundation Programme

## Application Process



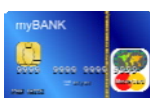
- If you would like to apply for the International Foundation Programme, you will need to attend an institution that has been given permission to teach. Please see the [website](#) and/or [The Institutions Directory](#) for a list of institutions.
- If there is an institution that you are able to attend, you should go to the institution to see if they are able to accept you onto the programme.



- The institution will check the qualifications that you have to see if they are willing to accept you.
- If they are able to accept you, they will issue you with an application code.
- You will then need to apply to the University of London who will check that you meet the General Entrance Requirements.
- Don't forget to include your application code on the University's application form, as otherwise you may experience delays in receiving the decision.



- To make an application, you should first read the information on the website about the programme.
- Then go to the University's online application form (your institution will have given you the web address with your application code).
- You should then click the 'New User' button.
- Upload any verified documents, complete the application form and submit the application.



- The application will then be considered in London and a response usually given within five working days.
- If you are eligible, an offer will be emailed with further instruction on how you can register and pay the programme fees.
- You will also be separately sent a username and password by email which will allow you to register.



- Once you have registered and paid your fees, you will be able to log in to the virtual learning environment (VLE) where you will be able to explore the study areas and keep up to date with programme announcements.
- Your study materials for the programme will also be available from here and you will be informed when the latest edition is available.
