All of the below entries must be awarded by an institution/university/authority that is acceptable to the University of London. This generally means the awarding body must have the appropriate power and/or has satisfied any relevant accreditation process that is required within the country of origin.

Acceptable equivalent: refers to when a university uses an alternative grading system to what we have published. If this is relevant to you then you can contact-us before submitting an application for advice on what we consider the acceptable equivalent to be.

Work Experience: in addition to satisfying our degree requirements you will be required to submit acceptable evidence of relevant work experience. Further details about what is considered relevant can be found at: Requirements

Pakistan	Master's degree (following a 4 year Bachelor degree): successful completion.
Poland	Licencjat / Inżynier / Bachelor degree (in and after 2002): provided a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.71 out of 5.0 is achieved or the acceptable equivalent.
Portugal	Licenciado: provided at least 13 out of 20 is achieved or the acceptable equivalent.
Qatar	Bachelor degree: provided a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.3 out of 5.0 is achieved or the acceptable equivalent.
Romania	Diplomă de Licență (Bachelor degree): provided at least 7.0 out of 10 is achieved or the acceptable equivalent.
Rwanda	Bachelor degree (Honours): provided at least Second Class (Lower Division) is achieved or the acceptable equivalent
Saudi Arabia	Bachelor degree: provided a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 3.3 out of 5.0 is achieved or the acceptable equivalent.

Switzerland	Bachelor degree (180 ECTS): provided an overall average of at least 4.0 out of 6.0 is achieved from all subjects taken or the acceptable equivalent
	Diplom / Diplôme / Diploma or the Lizentiat / Licence / Licenza: provided an overall average of at least 4.0 out of 6.0 is achieved from all subjects taken or the acceptable equivalent.
